Radiation legislation obliges dental practice owners and dentists to provide radiation safety training for all dental team members.

Safety training should be appropriate to the level of responsibility and tasks performed by persons who are working in the environment of ionising radiation to ensure their safety.

This mandated training is regulated by both the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) and the Health Information & Quality Authority (HIQA). A record of this training should be maintained for at least 5 years.
